

Terms, Conditions and General Information



Air Fares

All fares subject to change without notice. Transportation from Wisdom Tours is not mandatory. If you have frequent flyer or any other special ticket rates we welcome you to join us on a land basis only.

Cost of the Tour Includes

a. Hotels: Deluxe with private bath on the basis of two persons sharing a twin-bedded room. Best available rooms in remote areas. Single rooms must be reserved in advance at a supplementary cost. b. Meals: Three meals per day. Vegetarian meals available upon request. c. Luggage: Standard luggage restrictions apply on international flights. We recommend two pieces of checked baggage totaling no more than 44 lbs. A detailed recommended list of travel items will be sent to you before your trip departure. d. Transfers: Airport transfers for passengers arriving and departing on Wisdom Tours group flights. e. Gratuities: all gratuities to hotel staff, guides and drivers for normal on-tour travel services. f. Tour Manager: Wisdom Tours provides the services of Jim Hagan and/or Shelley Warren on all of our tours. g. Guided tours and sightseeing: all tours include English-speaking guides, entrance fees for places visited and all vehicles used during trip itinerary.

Cost of the Tour Excludes

Expenses of passports, visa fees, laundry, drinks, excess baggage, gratuities, airport departure taxes, extra meals, health, accident, baggage and trip cancellation insurance, international flights and any other personal services.

Insurance

Wisdom Tours is not responsible or liable for loss, damage or theft of personal luggage and belongings, nor can we be liable for personal injury, accident or illness. In most foreign countries, insurance coverage of personal injury, accident or illness is not available on the basis of U.S. standards. We strongly advise you to check with your insurance company to make sure you are adequately covered for any eventualities. You can purchase additional insurance from your insurance broker or an insurance company that covers luggage, personal effects, accident and health. We urge you to purchase trip cancellation insurance. We will send you an application on confirmation of your reservation, or in advance on request.

Health and Inoculations

No vaccinations are currently required for entry into Nepal. However, there are certain ones that we recommend for your protection such as Hepatitis A and B, Typhoid, and Polio. The decision should be between you and your physician.

Passport and Visas

A valid passport is needed for Nepal. Visas for Nepal will be obtained by Wisdom Tours. It is the responsibility of the individual to make sure they have the correct documentation.

Accommodations

In Nepal, Wisdom Tours will stay at Three Star hotels such as the Shankar Hotel and the Gangjong Hotel.

Pre-Departure Information

On confirmation of your booking, you will be sent a complete Wisdom Tour package of pre-departure information including visa information, flight itinerary, insurance form and a suggested list of things to bring.

Reservations

To make a reservation for this trip, please complete the enclosed tour application form and return it to Wisdom Tours, along with a deposit of \$300.00 in the form of a personal check. Upon receipt of your deposit, a confirmation letter, pre-departure information, invoice and insurance policy will be sent to you. No reservation can be made without a deposit. We urge you to book in advance before the trip fills up. Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure. About three weeks prior to departure, final documents, exact joining instructions and air tickets will be sent to you.

Cancellations and Refunds

Wisdom Tours must be notified in writing for all trip cancellations. All funds will be refunded in full, less the following cancellation charges: \$300.00 deposit is non-refundable. 59-31 days before departure 30% of the total land cost. 30-16 days before departure 45% of the total land cost. 15-0 days before departure 100% of the total land cost. Trip cancellation insurance is strongly recommended and available through Wisdom Tours. A policy will be forwarded to you when you reserve a space on this tour. Travel arrangements through Wisdom Tours are sold as a package. We regret that there can be no refunds for unused hotel rooms, meals, sightseeing, ground transportation or other services once this trip has commenced operation and/or after you have departed the USA.

Cancellation by Wisdom Tours

If we are forced to cancel the trip due to conditions beyond our control, our liability is limited solely to the cost of the land arrangements. Wisdom Tours cannot be responsible for financial loss due to the imposition of a charge by airline carriers on partially or totally non-refundable tickets.
